

Details and Description of the Wildlife Project 2009

- Artwork to be shown at the exhibit must be completed no later than **August 31, 2009**
- Artwork that does not pertain specifically to this project will not be accepted.
- Artwork that is produced for the Missisquoi Wildlife Project can not be submitted for the June 2009 Lake Champlain Quadra Centennial Festival show; these are two separate shows and must stay as such.

Artists

- The artist may render a reflection of the wildlife, its waters, scenic landscape, or the artist's interpretation of these not excluding abstract or contemporary works. Paintings may be in any two dimensional medium, oil, acrylics, watercolor, pen and ink, pastels or fabric related and able to hang.
- Artwork is **not to exceed 24x26 framed**.
- Artwork must be tagged or labeled on the back of your piece/pieces with the tags that will be supplied. **Please make sure to make a copy of your hanging tag and return to Karen at the address stated on the tag you received no later than August 15, 2009.**
- **This information will be needed for the hanging cards.**
- All pieces must be matted (where applicable) and framed being "ready to hang". Stretched canvas must have "finished" edges.

Photographers

- **Sizes should not be less than 9x12 and no larger than 16x20 to include mat and frame** and must be ready to hang.
- Artwork must be tagged or labeled on the back of your piece/pieces with tags that will be supplied. **Please make sure to make a copy of your hanging tag and return to Karen at the address stated on the tag you received no later than August 15, 2009.**
- **This information will be needed for the hanging cards.**

Note: Artists and photographers please keep to the size specified, otherwise your painting/image will be hung last and may not be hung at all due to the amount of artwork and space allotted. No exceptions.

Drop off will be at the Missisquoi National Wildlife Refuge during the following dates and times:

Wednesday September 9, 2009 and Thursday September 10, 2009 during the hours of 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and 6:00pm to 8:00pm on both days.

Exhibit Set Up & Take down

The Saint Albans Artists' Guild member artists and photographers who are participating will be responsible to help hang and take down artwork. Guild members will also be responsible for helping with the set up for the reception.

Set up for hanging: Friday 9/11/09 at 12:00 noon.

Reception Set up: Approximately 11:00 am to 12:00 pm on Saturday September 12, 2009
